

## CRITICAL SAFETY RULES

### All Operations.

**Critical Safety Rules are in place to prevent serious harm or death.**

Critical safety rules are to be adhered to without exception.

An observed breach of any critical safety rule will result in immediate two day suspension of the offending person and possible shut-down of the associated operation. A second breach of the same critical safety rule within two years may lead to termination of the contract and/or dismissal of the offending **ERNSLAW ONE** employee.

1. No person shall work in a manner likely to cause harm to themselves or others.
2. All persons entering, or working in, any forest operation shall wear / use the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment.
3. No person shall position themselves where there is danger of materials being dislodged and rolling or falling into their work area.
4. Drive to the conditions, not the radio, and be able to stop in half the visible distance ahead.

Note that many of **ERNSLAW ONE's** Task Specific Safety Rules are more stringent than in the Approved Code of Practice (2012).
