# Environmental Goal

- For environmental certification for market access
- Don't foul your own nest

# **Environmental Incident Procedure**

- Stop
- Secure the area
- Take remedial action if practicable
- Contact Ernslaw One

# Chemical or Fuel Spill

- Follow Ernslaw One emergency procedure
- Contain spill if practicable

You need to know:

- Emergency Procedure
- Location of Material Safety Data Sheets
- Location of spill kits

Why?

- Could be toxic chemical that may kill people, plants or animals.
- If gets into waterways, can spread quickly, and could be someone's drinking water



# Archaeological Sites

These are any place in NZ that was associated with human activity prior to 1900

Examples are:

Midden (Whangapoua)



Pit (East Coast)



Gold Mine (Whap)



Rock carving (Whap)



If an arch site is found or suspected:

- Stop work immediately
- Mark off area
- Notify Ernslaw One
- Do not remove anything

NZ Falcon  
(East Coast, Karioi, Waimarino, South



Island)

Native land Snail  
(Shannon)



Hochstetters Frog  
(Whangapoua, Littleworths)



Long-tailed Bat  
(Te Namu, Mangatu, Littleworths, Waimarino)



Brown Mudfish (Santoft)



If RTE species is known about, you will be given a mgmt plan and told what to do

If you make a new sighting or find:

- Stop operations that may affect them
- Mark off area
- Notify Ernslaw One
